As of March 1, 1989, the New Jersey DEP, Pesticide Control Program instituted a new program that requires us to provide the public with information about the materials that we will be using as part of the pest control program for town properties. We are using the consumer information notice to provide you with this information. We will apply the pesticides listed below to town properties on the dates listed:

You will also notice that, following each application, at least one sign will be placed on the treated property that says PESTICIDE TREATED AREA and contains the international signage for keep off grass. We are required to do this as part of the new program. The sign(s) must be posted before the application and be removed 72 hours following the application. As a resident, you should also be aware that you may request notification of the exact date(s) of our application and for a copy of the label for each pesticide that we will use.
