

BOROUGH OF SEA GIRT 2016 SANITATION AND RECYCLING SCHEDULE

RECYCLING DROP OFF FACILITY:

Location: Sea Girt Recycle Yard, Bell Place

Hours: Wednesday and Friday, 8:00 am to 2:45 pm

Saturday and Sunday, 8:00 am to 11:45 am

The yard has a container for each of the following acceptable recyclable items: cardboard, metal, bottles and cans, paper, electronics and household garbage. **NO bulk or garden trash will be taken.**

RECYCLING PICK UP

Schedule*

Zone 1- The Terrace to Baltimore Blvd. - **1st & 3rd Wednesday of the Month:**

Zone 2 - Philadelphia Blvd to Sea Girt Avenue - **2nd & 4th Wednesday of the Month:**

No pick up on the 5th Wednesday of the Month (*March 30, June 29, August 31, November 30*); recycling yard will be OPEN

**Unless otherwise noted on the holiday schedule on page 2.*

All recyclables will be picked up curbside or backyard (resident's choice) on your designated Wednesday unless otherwise noted in the Holiday Schedule.

If your sanitation, garden trash, and/or recycling has not been picked up according to schedule, please contact the Public Works Office as soon as possible prior to 2:00 PM. When contacting the Public Works Office, please provide your address and telephone number if leaving a message:

COMMINGLE RECYCLABLES:

Bottles, newspapers, junk mail, and cans may be commingled in open containers no larger than **30 gallons**. Containers must have holes in the bottom to drain off liquids and rainwater.

CARDBOARD: *separated* from all other recyclable material; must be broken down and tied in bundles

BOTTLES & CANS:

Includes aluminum cans, tin and bi-metal cans, glass bottles and jars, plastic "pourable containers";

EXCLUDES foil, pie tins, trays, cookware, dishware, light bulbs, ceramics and window glass. Be sure to empty any container used for automotive fluids.

SHREDDED or MIXED PAPER:

Includes letterhead, colored and white paper, junk mail, soft cover books, chipboard (e.g., cereal boxes).

All paper should be in a **bag** for pick-up. Styrofoam packing (peanuts) should be bagged and put with household trash.

HAZARDOUS WASTE – **NOT ACCEPTED:**

Paint, chemicals, fertilizers, leftover chemicals in containers etc., must be taken to the Monmouth County Household Hazardous Waste Facility. *Call 732-683-8686 ext. 5210 for an appointment.*

LEAVES - CURBSIDE PICK-UP:

April 15 to May 15 and October 15 to December 15.

Leaves are to be raked to the gutter. Piles of leaves may **not** be placed within 15 feet of a storm drain.

For safety reasons, piles of leaves may **not** be placed on Rt. 71 or less than 15 ft. from the intersection of any road and Rt. 71. **Do not mix grass, flowers or branches in the leaves.**

GARDEN TRASH PICK UP

January to March: March 7

April to December: Every Monday; beginning April 4, 2015. **No garden trash pickup on bulk days.** If a holiday falls on a Monday, pick up will be on Tuesday. Garden trash is to be placed at the curb (the area between the sidewalk and curb) **after 6:00 pm** the preceding Sunday **in open containers weighing no more than 50 lbs; 4 can limit per pick-up. Branches are to be tied in bundles no larger than 4 feet long by 2 feet in diameter,** or it will not be picked up. **There is no grass or topsoil pick up. Landscape contractors must remove all debris; Borough employees will not remove brush left by a contractor.**

BULK PICK-UP DAYS

March 14, May 16, September 12, October 17

Disposable household items should be placed at the curb after 6:00 pm the preceding Saturday. Doors must be removed from washers, dryers, refrigerators, etc. We will **not** pick up automobile parts, tires, building materials, tree stumps, chemicals, paints or concrete blocks, bricks, etc. **No garden trash pickup on bulk days.**

HOUSEHOLD TRASH DAYS

Schedule*

Zone 1 Monday and Thursday: The Terrace to Baltimore Blvd

Zone 2 Tuesday and Friday: Philadelphia Blvd to Sea Girt Ave

**Unless otherwise noted in the Holiday schedule*

Trash should be easily accessible and visible. Trash should be in secured in bags (**loose trash in a can will not be accepted**) for 7:00 am pick up. The staff is **not** permitted to enter **garages, sheds or homes** to collect trash. Metal cans and bungee cords should be used to deter animals.

WINTER TRASH COLLECTION

In the event of snow, trash may be placed at the curb **after snow plowing has been completed.** Trash will be picked up in the backyard only if there is a walkway free from snow and ice.

***2016 HOLIDAY SCHEDULE** There will be no trash or recycling collection on holidays. Listed below are the *dates for trash and recycling pick up before or after holidays:*

Lincoln's Birthday:	Tuesday, February 16	Zone 1&2 trash pick up
President's Day:	Tuesday, February 16	Zone 1&2 trash pick up
Good Friday:	Thursday, March 24	Zone 1&2 trash pick up
Memorial Day:	Tuesday, May 31	Zone 1&2 trash pick up
Fourth of July:	Tuesday, July 5	Zone 1&2 trash pick up
Labor Day:	Tuesday, September 6	Zone 1&2 trash pick up
Columbus Day:	Tuesday, October 11	Zone 1&2 trash pick up
Veteran's Day:	Thursday, November 10	Zone 2 recycling and Zone 1 trash pick up
Thanksgiving:	Monday, November 28	Zone 1 (regularly scheduled day)
Friday after Thanksgiving	Tuesday, November 29	Zone 2 (regularly scheduled day)
Christmas:	Tuesday, December 27	Zone 1&2 trash pick up
New Year's Eve/Day 2016:	Thursday, December 29	Zone 1&2 trash pick up
