

BOROUGH OF SEA GIRT 2019 SANITATION AND RECYCLING SCHEDULE

YARD LOCATION AND HOURS OF OPERATION:

Location: Sea Girt Recycle Yard, Bell Place

Hours: Wednesday through Friday, 8:30 am to 2:45 pm

Saturday and Sunday, 8:00 am to 11:45 am

The yard has a container for each of the following acceptable recyclable items: cardboard, metal, bottles and cans, paper, electronics and household garbage. NO bulk or garden trash will be taken.

RECYCLING PICK UP

Schedule*

Zone 1: The Terrace to Baltimore Blvd- 1st & 3rd Wednesday of the Month

Zone 2: Philadelphia Blvd to Sea Girt Ave- 2nd & 4th Wednesday of the Month

No pick up on the 5th Wednesday of the Month, recycling yard will be OPEN.

Weekly Whole Town Recycling resumes June 12, 2019 to September 4, 2019

PLASTIC BAGS CANNOT BE USED IN YOUR RECYCLING CAN. RECYCLING THAT DOES NOT CONFORM TO THE COUNTY'S REQUIREMENTS WILL NOT BE PICKED UP. All recyclables will be picked up on your designated Wednesday unless otherwise noted in the Holiday Schedule.

If your sanitation, garden trash, and/or recycling has not been picked up according to schedule, please contact the Public Works Office as early as possible, prior to 2PM. When contacting the Public Works Office, please provide your address and telephone number when leaving a message:

COMMINGLE RECYCLABLES:

Bottles, newspapers, junk mail, cardboard, and cans, may be commingled in open containers no larger than **30 gallons and no heavier than 50lbs.** Containers must have holes in the bottom to drain off liquids and rainwater. **DO NOT USE PLASTIC BAGS OR LINERS IN YOUR RECYCLING CONTAINER.**

CARDBOARD: *separated* from all other recyclable material; Must be broken down and tied in bundles or it will not be picked up.

BOTTLES & CANS: Includes aluminum cans, tin and bi-metal cans, glass bottles and jars, plastic "pourable containers". **EXCLUDES:** foil, pie tins, trays, cookware, dishware, light bulbs, ceramics and window glass. Be sure to empty any container used for automotive fluids.

MIXED PAPER:

INCLUDES: letterhead, colored and white paper, junk mail, soft cover books, chipboard (e.g., cereal boxes). All paper should be in a **bag** for pick-up. Styrofoam packing (peanuts) should be bagged and put with household trash.

HAZARDOUS WASTE – NOT ACCEPTED:

Paint, chemicals, fertilizers, leftover chemicals in containers etc., must be taken to the Monmouth County Household Hazardous Waste Facility. *Call 732-683-8686 ext. 5210 for an appointment.*

LEAVES - CURBSIDE PICK-UP:

April 15 to May 13 and October 15 to December 15.

Leaves are to be raked to the gutter. Piles of leaves may **not** be placed within 15 feet of a storm drain.

For safety reasons piles of leaves may **not** be placed on Rt. 71 or less than 15 ft. from the intersection of any road and Rt. 71. Do not mix grass, flowers or branches in the leaves, or they will not be picked up.

Leaves cleaned up by contractors must be removed by contractors as per town Ordinance.

GARDEN TRASH PICK UP

January to March: One pick up on Monday, March 4. If snow is predicted, please do not put out garden trash.

April to December: Every Monday; beginning April 1, 2019. No weekly garden trash pickup on bulk days. If a holiday falls on a Monday, pick up will be completed by Friday. Garden trash is to be placed at the curb (the area between the sidewalk and curb) **after 6:00 pm** the preceding Sunday **in open containers weighing no more than 50 lbs.; 4 can limit per pick up.** Branches are to be tied in bundles no larger than 4 feet long by 2 feet in diameter, or it will not be picked up. There is no grass or topsoil pick up. Landscape contractors must remove all debris; Borough employees will not remove brush left by a contractor. There are no facilities for garden debris in the Borough yard.

BULK DAYS

March 11, May 13, September 16, October 21

Disposable household items should be placed at the curb after 6:00 pm the preceding Saturday. Doors must be removed from washers, dryers, refrigerators, etc. Sanitation will **not** pick up automobile parts, tires, building materials, tree stumps, chemicals, paints or concrete blocks, bricks, etc. No weekly garden trash pickup on bulk days.

HOUSEHOLD TRASH DAYS

Schedule*

Zone 1 Monday and Thursday: The Terrace to Baltimore Blvd

Zone 2 Tuesday and Friday: Philadelphia Blvd to Sea Girt Ave

**Unless otherwise noted in the Holiday schedule*

Trash must be easily accessible and visible from your driveway. Trash should be secured in bags (**loose trash in a can will not be accepted**) for 7:00 am pick up. The staff is **not** allowed to enter **garages, sheds or homes** to collect trash. Metal cans and bungee cords should be used to deter animals.

WINTER TRASH COLLECTION

In the event of snow, trash may be placed at the curb after snow plowing has been completed. Trash will be picked up in the back yard **only if there is a walkway free from snow and ice.**

***2019 HOLIDAY SCHEDULE** There will be no trash or recycling collection on holidays. Listed below are the *dates for trash and recycling pick up before or after holidays.*
